Museum Working Party

The Museum Working Party has completed its work on developing a new Museum Collection Policy and is currently looking into options to increase storage for the museum and provide a multipurpose space for Society and museum activities as well as improving public access to the Society's library and resources.

The MWP sought the advice of local heritage architect, Barbara Hickson and representatives of MWRC in relation to the options listed in the Think Tank recommendations. The construction of a separate building behind the Slab Shed was preferred over closing in the Cottage verandahs. The advice received was useful in providing the requirements of any new structure to ensure it fits in with our heritage site. A full report on the MWP's activities will be provided to the membership at the AGM in August.

Committee Meeting

At our June committee meeting, the following items were discussed...

- At the May General Meeting it was suggested that the General Meeting minutes be uploaded onto RDHS website for member use with access via a password – the management committee opposed this suggestion.
- Approval for the purchase of 10 upholstered timber chairs and the upholstering of 5 existing chairs for the BVI dining room.
- Transfer of \$10,000 into a term deposit account with the CBA for 8 months.
- Sub-committee draft guidelines recommendations and procedures for consideration by management committee. *To be discussed further at the July Committee Meeting.*
- Future promotional activities at the BVI to have 'meaningful negotiations' for the recoup of utility costs.
